# Things you should know...

## Foundation Member Re-Carding Project

The Pelican Bay Foundation is re-carding association members. The specific date for St Raphael has already passed but if you still need to be re-carded, you may go to the Pavilion Shopping Center office space, Monday through Friday from 9AM to 5PM. This space is located directly behind Flemings Restaurant. You will be required to relinquish your existing Foundation photo ID card and present a government-issued form of picture ID (i.e. driver's license, passport, state ID).

## Garage Area and Bicycles

The staff has been working on assuring that our garage area is as clean and orderly as a garage can be. Summer plans include painting several areas of the garage. We have recently purchased additional bike racks to accommodate the many bicycles in our garage. All bicycles must be in a bike rack and space is on a first come-first serve basis. We will again be inspecting all bikes after season to determine if they are tagged and in working order or if they should be removed. We ask you, while you are here, to inspect your bikes to make sure they are operable and tagged. Tags may be obtained at the front desk. We have such a growing number of bikes, we ask that you please evaluate if you are using your bicycles and remove them if they are not operable or being used.



## Turtle Season

The beaches of southwest Florida have long been an important nesting area for the loggerhead sea turtle. The sea turtles emerge from the Gulf of Mexico to nest on our beaches each summer from May 1 to August 1. Females crawl from the Gulf late at night to lay their nests. The eggs will hatch after 60 days. Beachfront lights must be turned off and any lighting such as flashlights are strictly prohibited on the beach throughout the night from May to October as they can confuse sea turtles during the mating season. Suggested alternatives to decrease artificial lighting include use of motion sensors for safety, dark window tinting and curtains to cover inside light, and yellow incandescent light bulbs. Perhaps you will be lucky enough to witness the hatchlings leave their nest and head to the Gulf!



## St. Raphael Visitor Information

We have many visitors throughout our winter season that come here to enjoy our weather and amenities at St. Raphael. Here are some points of interest for our visitors:

**Boarding Passes-**Do you need Boarding Passes when you leave our paradise? Just stop in at the office or front desk and it would be our pleasure to print these for you.

**Swimming Pool Rules-**Our pool at St. Raphael is open from 8AM to dusk each day. The route to our pool is through the garage. Our lobby requires proper attire and the chlorine water and sand are very hard on the marble floors. Children must have adult supervision. Glass beverages are not permitted on the pool deck and all food should be confined to the tables provided.

**Guest Parking-** Parking is provided around the perimeter of the building in front of the villas or alongside the north and south garage areas. Please ask the gate staff to assist you if you cannot find parking.

**Wireless Internet Service-** Feel free to bring your laptop down to the lobby and connect to our wireless internet service. The front desk can assist you with connecting to this service.
